

Objective:

SUPPORT FOR UNIVERSITY STUDENTS

APIC will provide financial support to first-, second-, and third-generation Peruvian students residing in the United States.

This scholarship aims to support and encourage university education among young people, while also inviting reflection on the promotion of Peruvian culture abroad.



I. Requirements to Apply

1. Be a first-, second-, or third-generation Peruvian student residing abroad.
2. Have a minimum academic GPA of 3.0 or its equivalent.
3. Write an essay of at least 500 words in either Spanish or English that addresses the following topics:
 - A) The importance of Peruvian culture
 - B) How Latino culture influences your identity
 - C) Reflections on the customs and/or values of your parents' country of origin
 - D) Family anecdotes that have influenced the preservation of your culture and identity
4. Carrera universitaria orientada de preferencia al rango académico de:
 - Sciences, Social Sciences, Humanities
 - Philosophy, Language and Literature
 - Archaeology, Anthropology
 - History, and related areas.

II. Selection Process

A) Application Form, duly completed, must include the following information:

- Full name of the applicant
- Student's address
- Academic GPA
- Name of the academic institution where they will continue their studies

B) Deadline for submitting applications

Applications must be sent before the closing date via email to: Scholarship@apicperu.com

C) The essays will be evaluated by a committee made up of experts who are not members of the association.

D) Evaluation criteria:

- Quality of writing and clarity in the expression of ideas
- Depth of analysis and reflection on the importance of Peruvian culture
- Originality and authenticity of the content
- Relevance of personal experiences and their connection with Peruvian or Latin American culture

The recipients will be selected based on these criteria and will be notified via email.



III. Scholarship Amount

The total scholarship amount will be \$6,000.

Finalists:

First place: \$3,000

Second place: \$2,000

Third place: \$1,000**



IV. Conditions and Commitment:

Selected students must agree to use the scholarship exclusively for educational purposes related to continuing their university studies.

Recipients must submit confirmation of their enrollment in a university or higher-education institution, along with documentation showing the use of the awarded funds, within the first three months of receiving the scholarship.

Recipients may be invited to participate in APIC activities related to Peruvian culture.



V. When to Apply?

The application deadline will be April 31, 2026.

The selection process will take place during May 2026.

The evaluation panel will be composed of professional volunteers dedicated to preserving our cultural heritage, and who are not members of our Association.

The results will be announced in June 2026.

Interested applicants should contact the Scholarship Committee for more details.

The APIC Scholarship Program was created from the commitment of the members of the Peruvian International Cultural Association, who seek not only to support the education of young Peruvians abroad, but also to promote the strengthening of their cultural identity.

By offering this scholarship, we hope to help students reflect on the fundamental role that culture plays in shaping their identity.
